# History of Regulation

- 2008 – Michigan Medical Marihuana Act
- 2016 – Medical Marihuana Facilities Licensing and Marihuana Tracking Act
- 2018 – Michigan Regulation and Taxation of Marihuana Act
- 2019 – Executive Reorganization Order 2019-02

# Application Processing Status

- Patient and caregiver registry
  - 276,253 patients (446 minors)
  - 37,476 caregivers
- Medical Facility Licensure
  - 1,138 prequalifications
  - 145 growers, 20 processors, 178 provisioning centers (59 delivery services), 12 transporters, 6 labs
- Adult-Use Establishment Licensure
  - 48 prequalifications, 5 licenses, 65 social equity qualifiers

# Market Status

- Municipalities
  - Medical: 132 opted in
  - Adult-Use: 23 opted in, 1,403 opted out
- Medical Market Statistics
  - \$260M in retail sales
  - 108,000 plants in production
  - 21,000 pounds of flower available at retail
  - 99% of safety compliance tests passed
  - Average flower prices:
    - \$198.31 per ounce wholesale
    - \$261.58 per ounce retail
